- Create a 3 1/2 minute entertainment that will <u>WOW</u> the athletes and the audience
- > Fill out the application form, describing your group, and your entertainment number.
- Drop off your application form or e-mail it to the 2010 Arctic Winter Games Office at perform@awg2010.org
- > Deadline is September 30, 2009.

HELPFUL HINTS TO GET YOUR GROUP NOTICED:

- > Every entertainment number must be upbeat, exciting and well rehearsed.
- Every entertainment number must be based on one of the 52 virtues that help build quality youth and productive communities.
- > The list of **52 virtues** is attached.
- There are no restrictions on the type of entertainment as long as it is suitable for families.
- > Do what your group does best.
- Focus on entertaining youth between the ages of 14 and 20.
- > Do not be afraid to brag about your group's past successes.
- Do not exceed the 3 1/2 minute deadline!!!
